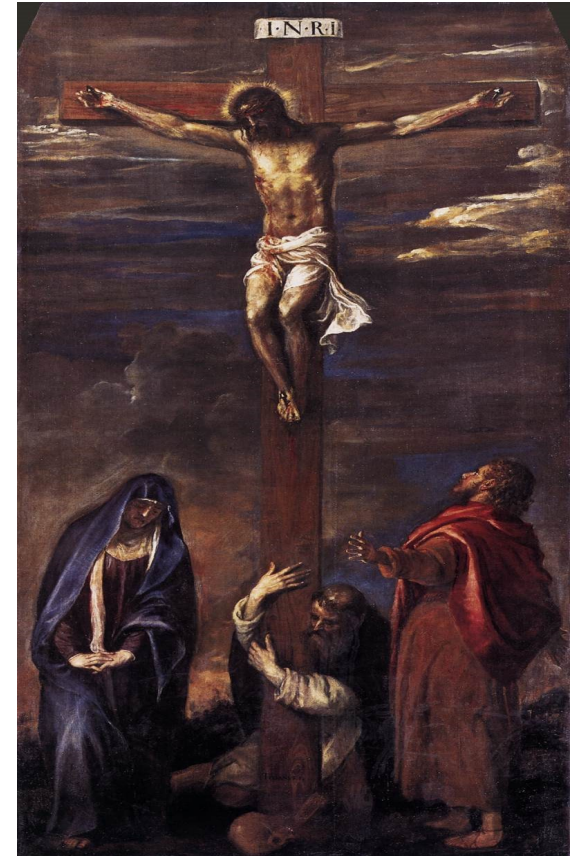
*FPCH Presents *A Christmas Carol*
