"Pentecost" comes from the Greek word for fifty, from the phrase "fiftieth day [after Easter]." The day of Pentecost is known in the Christian Church as the day on which the Holy Spirit descended upon the apostles. Guided by Peter's preaching, many thousands were converted in Jerusalem.
